- Improve student engagement in classrooms and in the playground through effective development and school-wide implementation of Positive Behaviour Learning strategies, resulting in the desired tier 1 behaviours.
- Increased number of students reaching age appropriate clusters on the Literacy Continuum in Aspects of Speaking and Vocabulary Knowledge and Reading Text.

- Engage the QELi team to provide professional development in Teach Like a Champion.
- Engage and forge relationships with regional staff, high performing teachers and para professionals to provision the teaching of literacy and build staff capability to improve student outcomes.
